

## **SUPPLY LIST FOR WATERCOLOUR FLORALS** **with MARIANNE BROOME**

- TUBE PAINTS** Professional/artist quality paints e.g. Winsor and Newton, Da Vinci, Holbein, Lukas, or Daler Rowney. Student quality paints such as Cotman or Van Gogh are less expensive for beginners but the same results cannot be expected and many colours will fade. The following colours will be required:
- Quinacradone Rose
  - Winsor Red or Cadmium Red
  - Quinacradone Magenta
  - Ultramarine Blue or French Ultramarine
  - Cobalt Blue
  - Aureolin Yellow or Winsor Yellow
  - Burnt Sienna
  - Winsor Violet or Dioxazine Violet
  - Warm Orange (Daler Rowney) or Cadmium Orange
  - Optional : Sap Green
    - Quinacradone Gold
    - Winsor (Pthalo) Blue or Antwerp Blue (**F**)
    - Cobalt Violet
- PAPER** **Please get** D'Arches, Winsor and Newton (not Cotman) or Saunders Waterford. Good quality watercolour paper is **essential**.
- 140 lb, acid-free cold press paper. Full sheets (22x30") to be cut into smaller sizes
  - OR 14"x 20" or larger D'Arches block
  - Scrap paper (white) or sketchbook and a notepad for notes
- BRUSHES** Synthetic watercolour brushes work well, although some prefer sable for the round ones
- 1/2", 3/4" synthetic bright (short flat) or filbert (oval). The bright is more useful if you also paint landscapes
  - 1 1/2" or 2" flat synthetic for large washes
  - #3or #4 and #10 round synthetic (e.g. gold sable or taklon)
  - A small, cheap (or old) synthetic round brush for applying making fluid
  - Optional : 1/4", 1" flat synthetic
- SUPPORT BOARDS** 18"x24" or 26"x34" (depending on paper size used) e.g. masonite, coroplast or plexiglass
- PALETTE** White plastic palette with big wells and large mixing area **and a lid** e.g. Robert E.Wood, John Pike, Quiller or Richeson
- OTHER MATERIALS**
- 2 plastic containers for water, 500ml or larger
  - HB pencil and a kneaded or soft white plastic eraser
  - Masking tape
  - Masking fluid and pick-up eraser
  - Small toweling rag and paper towel or toilet tissue
  - Spray bottle (fine mist)
