

SUPPLY LIST FOR ORANGE TULIPS IN ACRYLICS

with MARIANNE BROOME

PAINTS

I use **SOFT BODY** (Liquitex). If you already have regular or heavy body paints you can use these but they are harder to blend with.

Essential colours:

- Quinacradone Crimson
- Cadmium Red Medium Hue
- Cadmium Orange Hue
- Cadmium Yellow Medium Hue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Titanium White

Optional colours:

- Sap Green
- Prussian Blue
- Cadmium Yellow Light Hue or Hansa Yellow Light

MEDIUM

Acrylic Matte Medium (**liquid**) – only needed if you have heavy body paints

SUPPORT

Primed stretched canvas or canvas board suggested size 20x24 or 24x30.

BRUSHES

Synthetic acrylic brushes, **not bristle** oil painting brushes.

- 1 ½ or 2 inch flat
- 1/2", 3/4", 1" brights (short flat)
- No 4 or 6 round
- Optional - ¼ " bright
 - Filberts (oval) instead of brights - I use nos. 8, 10 and 14

PALETTE

I suggest the Masterson Sta-Wet Premier Palette. 12.5 x 16.5 inches. Keeping your paint moist will make it easier to use and save a lot of waste. And paper or styrofoam plates OR disposable paper palette.

OTHER

- Plastic containers for water
- Paper towel
- Pieces of old towel/rag or shop cloths
- Fine mist spray bottle
- Small sketchbook or scrap paper
- Pencil
- Water-soluble pencils or blackboard chalk
