

# SUPPLY LIST FOR PINK TULIPS IN WATERCOLOUR

## ONLINE CLASS with MARIANNE BROOME

### TUBE PAINTS

These are the colours used in the video demonstration:

Permanent Rose  
Bright Rose or Quinacradone Crimson  
Thioindigo Violet  
Aureolin Yellow (or Winsor Yellow) or Cadmium Yellow  
Cadmium Red  
Ultramarine Blue or French Ultramarine

Note: Use Da Vinci Aureolin Yellow. The Winsor and Newton Aureolin has a greenish tinge that is not good for flowers.

### PAPER

D'Arches 140 lb, acid-free cold press paper. Full sheet (22x30") or half sheet.  
The demo painting is more of a square format.

### BRUSHES

Synthetic watercolour brushes work well, although some prefer sable for the round ones.

1/2 3/4" synthetic bright (short flat) or filbert (oval).  
1 1/2" or 2" flat synthetic wash brush  
#3 or #4 and #10 round synthetic (e.g. gold sable or taklon)  
A small, cheap (or old) synthetic round brush for applying making fluid  
Optional: 1/2 "bright or filbert

### SUPPORT BOARDS

18"x24" or 26"x34" (depending on paper size used) e.g. masonite, coroplast or plexiglass

### PALETTE

White plastic palette with wells for paint or large white plate

### OTHER MATERIALS

2 plastic containers for water, 500ml or larger  
HB pencil and a kneaded or soft white eraser  
Masking tape  
Masking fluid and pick-up eraser  
Small toweling rag and paper towel or toilet tissue  
Spray bottle (fine mist)
